Apply for funding

Your school may apply for and qualify for funding for your oral health event which must take place during the week of September 6-12, 2010.

A maximum of \$1,000 will be granted to individual schools. Applications close on Monday August 16.

Funding is limited, hence not all applications will be funded. Applications will be assessed on the following criteria by the NZDA project team:

- 🍏 Whole school approach - involvement from students, staff and parents
- 🍏 Innovative projects that lead to awareness about importance of oral health

Preference will be given to low decile schools and schools with high Maori and Pacific population. You will be advised of the funding decision via email on August 23, 2010.
